Bouin's Fluid

Description: Bouin's Fluid is a fixative useful for routine procedures. Bouin's Fluid contains formaldehyde for

cytoplasmic fixation, and picric acid for chromatin.

Storage: Store at room temperature. Do not use beyond the expiration date stated on the label.

Procedure:

- 1. Trim specimen to smallest practical size.
- 2. Cover tissue with an amount of fluid equal to 20 times the specimen volume.
- 3. Fixation times range from 5 to 24 hours depending on specimen size.
- Treatment with 70% alcohol saturated with lithium carbonate will facilite removal of yellow pigmentation prior to staining.

Precautions: Poison. Do Not Take Internally.
